Have a beak.



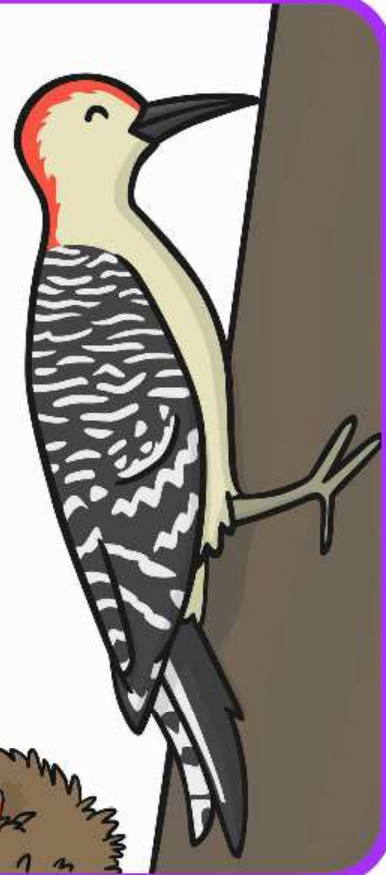

Have fins not legs.

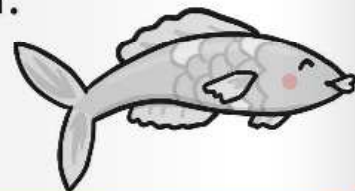
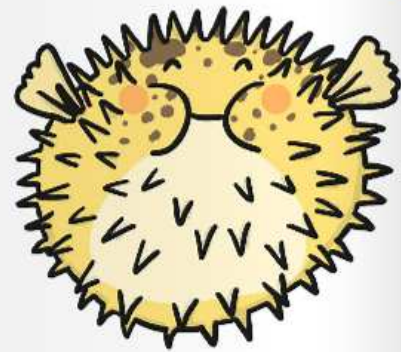


Have gills instead of lungs, to breathe under water.

We are mammals.

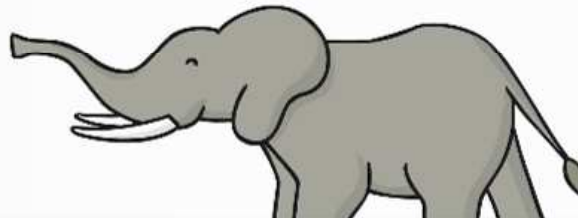


Have hair or fur.

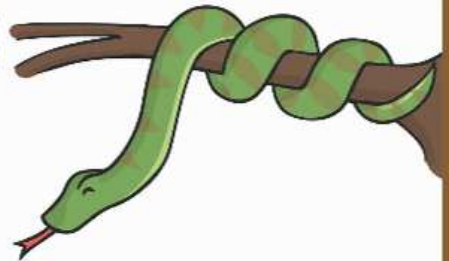


Give birth to live young.

Live on land and water.



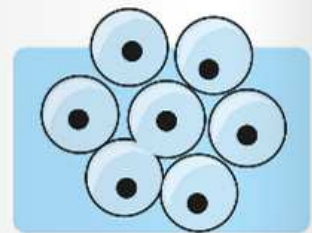
Lay eggs.
